Lama Foundation is located on 110 acres at 8600 feet elevation in the Sangre de Cristo Mountains, 20 miles north of Taos. Started in 1967 as a spiritual intentional community, it features rustic off-the-grid living, natural beauty, heart-felt group activities, and opportunities for personal growth. In 1996 a 7000-acre forest fire greatly reduced Lama's infrastructure, and the rebuilding effort has provided an excellent natural building and permaculture learning experience.
